

PROGRAM FOR THE “IV INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP ON LANDSCAPE”

1. - PROGRAM

1.1.- The technical documentation of the Proposal which is attached, should be analyzed by each student for one month before the Workshop takes place, with the aim of clarifying as many doubts as necessary.

1.2.- The Workshop will take place at the **School of Architecture of Málaga** (Campus of El Ejido s/n, Málaga), from the **23rd to the 27th of July**, with the following **PROGRAM:**

MONDAY 23rd JULY

10h.- Reception and Registration of the participants in the School of Architecture of Málaga.

11h.- Inauguration of the Workshop, with presentation of the project and distribution of groups.

12h.- Guided tour of the work site.

17h-20h.- Group work in the Workshop, with presentations and discussions.

TUESDAY 24th through THURSDAY 26th JULY

10h-20h.- Group work in the Workshop, with presentations and discussions.

FRIDAY 27th of JULY

10h-20h.- Preparation and exhibition of the completed works in the Auditorium of the School of Architecture, and awarding of the Official Diplomas.

2. - OBJECTIVE OF THE PROJECT

Distribution and project solutions for the urban area of **Paseo del Muelle Heredia**, as an element of transition between the Port of the City and its Historic Center, in it's three levels of analysis: the territorial, the urban and the architectural.

Graphic documentation is attached of the first approximation of the area that can be built on, of 30,900 m², for third party use (Offices, Hotels, Installations...) and subterranean parking, as well as cartography and areal photos.

The objective is to present a project proposal which solves the problems of urban and landscape connection in the existing relation of Port-City.

3. - MATERIAL TO BE PRESENTED

The work will be developed in teams (of between 6-8 students) with tutoring by two professors per group and a series of proposals which will be held in the classroom of the Workshop.

The proposal will be submitted in digital format on CD, with a copy on paper DIN A-3. Each student should bring their own personal computer, with the organization providing reproduction and printing equipment, Internet, working material, etc.
